Job Description

The Director provides leadership and administration that motivates and inspires teachers and staff to provide the best possible opportunities for students' growth and development. The Director sets the tone for and models the mission and vision of the school. The Director is responsible for all elements of hiring and managing staff and the day-to-day operations of the school while ensuring that the school practices support the school mission and philosophy.

Key Responsibilities

- **Leadership-** guide and inspire school faculty, manage staff and operations and serve as the face of the school in the community, act as the primary liaison for families
- **Staff and Curriculum Management-** hire, supervise and evaluate staff, oversee scheduling and curriculum development
- **Admissions-** meet with prospective parents, lead tours of the school, observe child visits, make final admissions decisions and welcome new families
- **Finances-** manage finances, develop budget, oversee bookkeeping, payroll and benefits administration
- **Fundraising-** build relationships with major donors, solicit contributions, maintain gift records, coordinate annual auction to accomplish agreed upon goals
- **Board of Trustees-** participate in recruitment, partner to develop board agenda, provide appropriate information and financial reports, guide strategic planning
- **Communications & Community Building-** manage website and written communications, organize community events, serve as primary liaison for the neighborhood residents and businesses
- **Compliance Responsibilities-** ensure that the school is in full compliance with all licensing and safety regulations

Desired Qualifications

In addition, qualified candidates will have progressively responsible leadership and staff management experience and successful financial management skills.
